Frankfurt's Top 10

Römerberg: Time-honoured town centre featuring Römer City Hall, historical timber-frame architecture and St Nicholas Church

New Old Town: Magnificent building ensemble reconstructed according to original blueprints

Cathedral: Election and coronation site of numerous German kings and Holy Roman emperors

St Paul's Church: Seat of the first German National Assembly, held in 1848

Frankfurt Skyline: Unique in all of Europe

Old Sachsenhausen: Frankfurt's famous apple wine quarter, featuring pubs and shops built in the historical timber-frame style

Palmengarten: Pristine botanical gardens featuring numerous tropical greenhouses and the unique Blossom and Butterfly House

Frankfurt Zoo: Zoological home to lions, penguins, meerkats and a further 447 animal species

Höchst: Picturesque city district featuring historical timber-frame architecture, a mediaeval castle and St Justin's Church

Museum Embankment: One-of-a-kind museum landscape set scenically along the River Main


